For the upcoming season, the guest list also includes award nominee Leigh Nash who, as former lead singer of Sixpence None the Richer, has appeared numerous times on the "Tonight Show" with Jay Leno; Krystal Meyers, a pop-rock artist whose single "Anticonformity" knocked the Red Hot Chili Peppers out of the number one slot in Japan; Seventh Day Slumber, an upbeat, ministry-driven rock band; and Eleventy Seven, newcomers on the pop-punk scene whose "More Than a Revolution," cut from their debut CD, made it to number five on the Christian rock singles chart.
