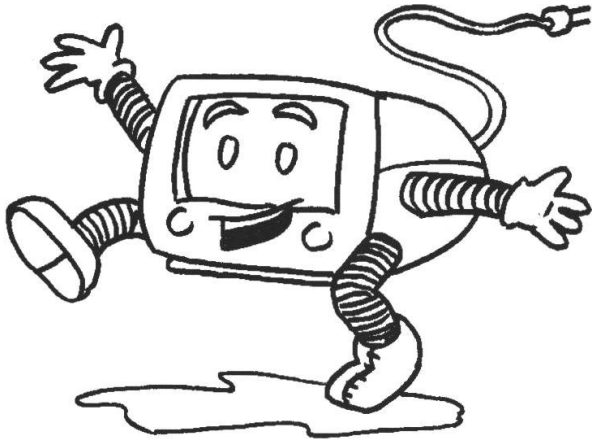


Personal Safety Tips for Young People



Internet Safety :

- * Do not give out personal information about yourself, your family situation, school, telephone number, or address.
- * Do not send a person you do not know your picture or anything else without first checking with your parents.
- * When in chat rooms, remember that not everyone may be who they say they are. For example a person who says "she" is a 14-year-old girl from Texas may really be a 48-year-old man from California.
- * If someone harasses you online, says anything inappropriate, or does anything that makes you feel uncomfortable, tell your parents right away so that they can contact the online service and report it.
- * Talk to your parents about rules for going online. Decide on the time of day that you can be online, the length of time to be online, and appropriate areas to visit online. Do not access other areas or break the rules without their permission.
